- Your username and password for online and mobile banking will stay the same. You'll need to log in with this information before you can use features like Touch ID or Face ID. If you don't remember your login credentials, give us a call at 855-844-6151.
- When you're ready to log into your updated Bank of Pontiac Online Banking, please use the sign in page directly from our website, www.bankofpontiac.com. Please do not log into any saved websites or bookmarks that you have used previously.
- When your upgrade is ready to go, our Bank of Pontiac Mobile Banking App will automatically ask you to download the new version.
- If you use bill pay, your existing bill payments and payees will automatically copy to the new system.
- Transfer functionality will be unavailable from 4pm CST on Monday, November 13 to 9am CST on Tuesday,
 November 14. Scheduled internal transfers, recurring and external transfers will all be processed as scheduled.
- If you have existing account and/or transaction alerts setup, you will need to reset these with our new system –
 they will not automatically transfer.
